- **Welkin’s Triumph:** Complete the main story campaign. This is your first major milestone and the foundation for all other trophy hunting.
- **What is a Valkyria?:** Witness the awakening of a Valkyria during a key cutscene. This is a pivotal moment in the plot and impossible to miss.
- **Protect the Homeland:** Complete Chapter 1, which serves as the tutorial. It introduces the core mechanics of the BLiTz system.
- **The Gallian Volunteer Militia:** Unlock the ability to rename your units. This happens early in the game and is a simple narrative trigger.

These story-related successes will provide a solid start, but the real challenge begins once the credits roll. For a complete Valkyria Chronicles PS3 trophy guide, you must look beyond the main campaign.

MASTERING THE BATTLEFIELD: OFFENSIVE AND DEFENSIVE TROPHIES

The majority of your time as a trophy hunter will be spent perfecting your performance on the battlefield. Valkyria Chronicles demands a high level of tactical execution. Two of the most intimidating trophies fall into this category: acquiring an A rank on every mission and ensuring zero casualties throughout the entire game. While daunting, they are achievable with the right approach.

The A-Rank Challenge: Speed and Efficiency

To achieve an A rank on a mission, you must complete it within a specific turn limit. The game judges your performance almost entirely on speed. Killing every enemy is rarely the objective; completing the primary objective is. This is where the infamous “Scout Rush” tactic becomes invaluable. Scouts have high movement and evasion, allowing them to dash across the map and capture enemy bases or reach the target point in record time. Equip your Scouts with the best rifles you have and order them forward aggressively. Use Orders like “Defense” and “Awareness” from your Commander units to boost their survivability. While this strategy feels anything but strategic, it is the most reliable way to earn those elusive A ranks, a cornerstone of any effective Valkyria Chronicles PS3 trophy guide.

The No-Death Run: Patience and Restarts

The trophy for completing the game without a single unit being incapacitated is arguably the most stressful. If any unit—including the generic soldiers you recruit—falls in battle, you must restart the entire mission. The game does not count a death if you restart before the battle ends, so do not hesitate to hit the pause button and reload your save. Here are key tactics for this run:

- **Over-level your units:** Grind a few skirmishes to level up your favourite troops. Higher levels mean higher HP and damage, reducing the risk of sudden death.
- **Master the Orders system:** Orders are your lifeline. “Defense” halves damage taken for a turn, while “Awareness” drastically increases evasion. Use them liberally.
- **Never rush blindly:** While A ranks require speed, a no-death run requires caution. Scout rush is still useful, but only if you can ensure the Scout survives. Use smoke screens and check overlapping fields of fire before moving.
- **Utilise the Tank:** The Edelweiss is a powerful asset. Use it to draw enemy fire and destroy heavy weapon emplacements from a safe distance. Shield your infantry behind its bulk.

Many players combine the no-death run with the A-rank grind. This is efficient but requires immense concentration. A safer method is to do a relaxed playthrough first to unlock all skirmishes, then tackle the ultimate challenge in New Game+ with all your upgraded weapons and equipment. This approach is highly recommended in any serious Valkyria Chronicles PS3 trophy guide.

THE GRIND: EXPERIENCE, FUNDS, AND WEAPONRY

Beyond pure combat skill, several trophies require a significant time investment. These involve maxing out your units and collecting every piece of equipment the game has to offer. This is where the grind sets in, but it can be streamlined.

Maxing Out Your Units

The trophy for maxing out all classes of infantry requires you to earn a huge number of experience points. The most efficient way to do this is by replaying the early skirmish, “Skirmish 1: Barious Desert.” This small map can be completed in one or two turns with a Scout rush, yielding a decent amount of experience for the time spent. Focus on using different classes each time to ensure balanced growth. Do not neglect your Engineers or Lancers, as they are often used less frequently but are crucial for the trophy. Collecting Weapons and the Hidden R&D Reports

To unlock every weapon, you must find all R&D Reports hidden throughout the campaign. These are often located in obscure corner of the map or require you to capture a specific base before an enemy unit destroys the report. This is the most missable part of the entire trophy list. Use a chapter-by-chapter checklist when playing. If you miss a single report, you will have to replay the entire chapter to retrieve it. Similarly, the trophy for collecting all tank parts requires you to find hidden turrets, engines, and armour on specific maps. These are usually earned by defeating the Ace enemy units that appear on certain missions. Never skip an opportunity to hunt down an Ace on the battlefield—they drop unique weapons and parts that are essential for your collection.

EXPLORING EVERY CORNER: HIDDEN AND MISSABLE TROPHIES

Valkyria Chronicles rewards exploration and completionism. Several trophies are tied to activities that are easy to overlook if you are rushing through the story. Pay close attention to the following to avoid a second playthrough solely for clean-up.

The Skipped Turn Trophy and Other Oddities

One of the more unusual trophies requires you to skip a turn in battle. This means selecting the “End Turn” command without moving a single unit. While this seems wasteful, it is required for the trophy. You can easily do this on a skirmish map where you are overwhelmingly powerful without risking your no-death run. Another hidden gem is the trophy for visiting the cemetery. There is a specific grave in Bruhl that you must interact with during a free period. These small, narrative-driven interactions are easy to miss if you never return to previous locations. A diligent Valkyria Chronicles PS3 trophy guide will remind you to speak to every NPC and examine every interactable object during the intermission chapters.

Ace Hunters and the Encyclopedia

To fill your character profiles, you must defeat every named Ace enemy in the game. These elite units appear only once, usually on specific missions, and often retreat or have special conditions for their appearance. Some Aces only appear if you trigger certain events within a battle, such as capturing a specific base before a set turn. If you fail to defeat them, you miss the profile forever on that playthrough. The trophy for accumulating a million DCT (the game’s currency) will also come naturally if you diligently replay skirmishes for experience and sell duplicate weapons from defeated Aces. Patience is key here; do not burn yourself out grinding for currency when the experience grind will provide it naturally.

ADVANCED STRATEGIES FOR THE PLATINUM TROPHY

Having covered the individual components, let us synthesize this into a cohesive plan of action. The most efficient path to the Platinum trophy in Valkyria Chronicles involves a minimum of two complete playthroughs, though a third is often used for cleanup.

Playthrough One: The Relaxed Experience

Focus on enjoying the story and collecting every R&D Report, tank part, and Ace kill. Do not worry about turn counts or casualties. Use this playthrough to unlock all skirmishes and understand the AI patterns of each enemy unit. This is also the time to experiment with different classes and find the soldiers you prefer. Pay close attention to hidden interactable objects in the town segments. This foundation is critical for a stress-free trophy journey.

Playthrough Two: The Perfection Run

Load your New Game+ save. You will have all your upgraded weapons, orders, and tank parts from the first playthrough. This is the run where you aim for all A ranks and zero deaths simultaneously. The power of your units will make the early and mid-game significantly easier. The final chapters remain challenging, so save often in different slots. If a mission goes poorly, reload immediately. Do not accept any casualties. This is the true test of your tactical skill and the central focus of this entire Valkyria Chronicles PS3 trophy guide.

Post-Game Cleanup

If you are missing any specific medals or skirmish-related trophies, now is the time to mop them up. Focus on the tedious grind for maximum class levels. Use the “Barious Desert” skirmish repeatedly.
