### IS DISCOVERY CHANNEL IN 4K ON U-VERSE?

As of now, AT&T U-verse does not offer Discovery Channel in native 4K resolution. However, the HD feed is of very high quality, and upscaling on a 4K television still provides a great viewing experience. If 4K is essential to you, you might want to explore streaming options through the Discovery GO app or other streaming services that offer select content in ultra-high definition.
